


# Directions to DRIVE. Volkswagen Group Forum



### In the heart of the German capital - right in the centre of Berlin

DRIVE. Volkswagen Group Forum is located at the intersection of Friedrichstraße / corner of Unter den Linden, just a few minutes' walk from the Brandenburg Gate, Checkpoint Charlie and Alexanderplatz. The main entrance is at Friedrichstraße 84, the entrance to the meeting and conference area is on the Unter den Linden boulevard 21a.

#### Many routes lead to DRIVE

The best way to quickly and conveniently get around in the centre of Berlin is by public transport. You can choose from regional trains, U-Bahn (underground rail), S-Bahn (suburban rail), tram or bus. U-Bahn and S-Bahn: 1 minute from Unter den Linden station (U5, U6), 5 minutes from Friedrichstraße (S5, S7, S75, S1, S2, S25) and Brandenburg Gate (S1, S2, S25). Bus: lines 100, 245 and 300 arrive right outside the door at the Friedrichstraße/Unter den Linden stop. Tram: 5 minutes from the Friedrichstraße stop (M1 and M12)

## From Berlin Central Station (Hauptbahnhof) to DRIVE

Berlin's main railway station is only three U-Bahn stations away from Unter den Linden (U5). You can reach DRIVE quickly and conveniently from the mainline platform in just 15 minutes.

## From the airport to DRIVE

From Berlin's BER airport, you can reach DRIVE in about 30-50 minutes, depending on the traffic situation and means of transport. Eleven connections between BER and the city centre offer optimal access to the capital city's local transport system by regional train (RE7, RB22, RB14 and FEX) or by S-Bahn (S9 and S45). The BER station located directly below the main terminal offers

convenient access to the airport check-in area – no need to worry about traffic jams or search for parking spaces.

#### Getting to DRIVE by car

Coming to DRIVE in your own two or four wheels? Parking is available in the public car park on Bebelplatz (entrance at Behrenstraße 37) and along the side streets in the surrounding area. Due to the central location, it may take a while to find a parking space. It's best to use one of the many Park & Ride facilities at regional and S-Bahn stations and change to the Berlin public transport system at the city limits.

## Barrier-free access

The DRIVE entrances on Friedrichstraße and Unter den Linden boulevard allow easy access for wheelchair users. You can also take a lift from our shop directly to the exhibition area. Lifts located on the ground floor connect all levels in the DRIVE building.

## **Conference guests**

Direct access to the DRIVE meeting and conference area on the 1st upper level is at Unter den Linden boulevard 21a located only 100 metres from the intersection of Friedrichstraße/Unter den Linden in the direction of Charlottenstraße. From our exhibition area you can also reach the entrance to the conference area via the special exhibition section.
